

4 JYOTHIRLANGA YATRA - (27-01-2026) 11N/12D, 38,500 per person



This sacred journey covers four important Jyotirlinga temples located across Madhya Pradesh and Gujarat. The pilgrimage begins in **Ujjain**, where devotees seek blessings at the historic **Mahakaleshwar Jyotirlinga**, famous for its divine *Bhasma Aarti*. The tour continues to **Omkaleshwar**, situated on the banks of the holy Narmada River, where Lord Shiva is worshipped in the serene Mandhata Island.

The yatra then moves to **Somnath**, one of the most ancient and revered Jyotirlingas, located on the shores of the Arabian Sea in Gujarat. The final darshan is at **Nageshwar Jyotirlinga** near Dwarka, believed to protect devotees from all forms of negative energy.

This tour combines spirituality, culture, and history, offering devotees a deeply peaceful and divine experience while visiting some of the most powerful Shiva shrines in India.

Day 1: Hyderabad - Indore - Ujjain(55-65km) (1-1.5hr)

Travel by flight from Hyderabad to Indore.

After checking your belongings, our travel agent will take you to Ujjain.

Check into the hotel room, take some rest, and then we will show you the local Ujjain sightseeing points such as:

Mahakaleshwar Jyotirlinga

Harsiddhi Mata Shaktipeeth

Shri Ram Ghat

Shri Kal Bhairav Temple

Chintamani Ganapati

Day 2: Ujjain - Indore(55-65km) (1-1.5hr)

Early morning around 2:00 AM, proceed for Bhasma Aarti.


Return to hotel, have breakfast, check out, and proceed to Indore.

In Indore, we will visit:

Bada Ganapati

Vaishnavi Mahamandir

Then we will depart for **Omkaleshwar**. (75-78km)(2.5-3hr)



Night Halt at Omkaleshwar


Day 3: Omkaleshwar - Vadodara(250-280km) (6-7hr)

Early morning visit to the Narmada River for holy rituals.

Then proceed for Omkareshwar Jyotirlinga darshan followed by visit to Mamleshwar.

After breakfast, check out from the hotel and depart to Vadodara, Lunch en route.

Upon arrival, check in to hotel.




Night Halt at Vadodara.

Day 4: Vadodara - Nathdwara (280-300km) (6-6.5hr)

Morning: After breakfast, visit Statue of Unity, Museum & View Point.(2-2.5hr)

From there, proceed to Thakur Dwarka Temple, complete darshan and continue journey to Nathdwara.

Day 5: Nathdwara - Mount Abu (160-180km) (4-4.5hr)

Morning: Wake up in the morning at Nathdwara, have breakfast, then go for ShriNathji Darshan.

After darshan, proceed to Mount Abu.

On the way, visit Kankroli Dwaraka.

Day 6: Mount Abu - Siddhpur (135-155km) (4-4.5hr)

Morning: After breakfast, local sightseeing in Mount Abu:

Brahma Kumaris Temple

Jain Temple

Mata Temple

Afternoon: After lunch, depart for Siddhpur, visiting Ambaji Temple en route.

Reach Siddhpur.

Day 7: Siddhpur - Bhavnagar (220-260km) (5-6hr)

Perform Pind Pradanam and other rituals at Matrugaya.

After breakfast, depart to Bhavnagar, Lunch en route.

Reach Bhavnagar.

Day 8: Bhavnagar - Somnath

Morning: After breakfast, visit Nishkalank Mahadev Temple, located inside the sea.

On extremely high tide days, only the flag and pillar are visible; the temple remains submerged under the sea.(30-40km)(1-1.25hr)

After darshan, depart to Somnath.(190-220km)(4.5-5.5hr)

Lunch en route.

Reach Somnath.

Day 9: Somnath - Dwarka

Early morning after bath and traditional attire, visit:


Somnath Jyotirlinga

Bhalka Tirth

Triveni Ghat

Then depart for **Porbandar** – visit Gandhi Ashram.(125-135km)(3-3.5hr)

Continue to **Dwarka**, reach by night.(100-110km)(2.5-3hr)

Day 10: Dwarka

Morning: After breakfast, local sightseeing at Dwarka:

Dwarkadhish Temple

Rukmini Temple

Kirti Mandir

Sudama Temple

Gopi Talav

After lunch, visit:

Nageshwar Jyotirlinga(18-20km)(30-40min)

Bet Dwarka(35-40 km)(1 hr (road) + 30 min boat approx)

Return to Dwarka.

Night Halt at Dwarka

Day 11: Dwarka - Ahmedabad (440-470km) (8.5-9.5hr)


Early morning at 4:00 AM, depart for Ahmedabad.

Visit major sightseeing spots:

Jain Temple

Gandhi Ashram

Sardar Vallabhbhai Patel Museum

Day 12: Ahmedabad - Hyderabad

Morning: After breakfast, if any local sightseeing remains, it will be covered or you can go shopping.

In the evening, travel back to **Hyderabad**.

TERMS & CONDITIONS:

Tourists are required to make an advance payment of fifty percent of the total amount during the booking process, with the remaining balance due one week before the scheduled departure.

No refunds will be provided if a tourist cancels the tour, and the advance/full amount will not be refunded (refer to the Cancellation Policy).

Adherence to the time schedule announced by the Tour Operator/Guide is essential to cover all planned destinations. Conveyance charges from the bus alighting point to hotels/temples and other locations inaccessible to tourist buses due to traffic regulations are the responsibility of the tourists. In the case of any tour extensions or delays, a daily charge ranging from Rs. 2,000 to Rs. 5,000 will be applicable.

CANCELLATION RULES:

Cancellation before 30 days from the date of booking incurs a 10% charge on the Tour package amount, excluding train, flight, helicopter, and cruise cancellation charges. Cancellation between 30 days to 15 days will result in a 25% charge from the tour package amount.

Cancellation between 15 days to 7 days incurs a 50% charge of the Tour package amount.

Cancellation less than 7 days before departure will not be eligible for any refund. Cancellation within 7 days with a reference to other customers will result in a 75% refund added to the new customer.

Any expenses incurred due to reasons beyond our control, such as bad weather, natural calamities, roadblocks, flight/helicopter/train delays, excess baggage, rescheduling or cancellations, accidents, medical evacuations, riots, strikes, war, airline or hotel policies, etc., are not the responsibility of the tour operator.
